#1. Failure to file accurate, timely C3 and C4 reports, failure to timely deposit contributions.

9/18/17 to 10/5 is not 34 days.

In 2015 my treasure had problems with ORCA and she worked mostly with Jennifer Hansen. We have all the reports and they were filed as soon as my treasure was able to discuss with the PDC officer.

#2. Failure to report last minute contributions.

All my contributions on listed in the forms and filed timely.

#3 Failure to list committee officers, timely file/update.

I was the officer and there is no date on the committee filing. I do not believe it was late. I was the only person who made, directed, or authorized expenditures, strategic or policy decisions on behalf of myself.

#4. Illegal unauthorized expenditure of funds by an individual not listed as an officer.

I was the only person who authorized or spent funds for my campaign.

#5. Failure to preserve books of account, bills, receipts and all other financial records.

I have all campaign books, receipts and all other financial records from 2015 and 2017.

#6. Illegal depositing of campaign funds into bank account by person other than the treasurer.

2017 I am listed at the treasure. Not sure about about 2015, though I was unaware depositing funds could not be done by the candidate.

#7. Failure to include sponsor ID.

Sponsor ID was included on all paid political advertising.

#8. Failure to timely file form C6 reporting independent expenditure.

I had no independent expenditures.
