- Membership dues, an occasional raffle at monthly meetings and a donation jar used to augment our shoe box fund

Does the RWCC receive dues monies from members?

- As a social club we pay dues each year.

Does the RWCC receive monies from any other sources?

- No outside funding. Refer to item #1.

Did the RWCC solicit contributions from members in calendar year 2020 in order to contribute funds to candidates or political committees?

- No.

Has the RWCC solicited contributions from its members during the calendar year 2021 in order to contribute to candidates or political committees?

For calendar year 2020, what was the annual budget of the RWCC?

- No formal budget is prepared.

- Our club expenditures were \$1,350.

- Dues paid \$350.00

Does the RWCC expect to make any contributions to candidates in the 2021 election cycle? If yes, how much in total contributions have been allocated or budgeted for this purpose?

- Yes - \$200.00. We do not allocate or budget for contributions to candidates. Any donations to candidates come from reserve funds after any obligations have been met.
