RE: Democrats of Pacific County alleged violation #1 of RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240, and RCW 42.17A.220 (1), and alleged violation #2 of RCW 42.17A.240 and RCW 42.17A.235, per PDC complaint #142009 filed by Glen Morgan on August 30, 2023.

The following materials are submitted in response to the PDC email dated September 8, 2023.

While there is a litany of accusations levied by Mr. Morgan in his complaint, we will be generally focused on responding to the primary allegations. However, we have attached letters dated 01/07/2019, 4/26/2019, and 03/11/2022, addressing the details of the dismissal of all previous complaints referred to by Glen Morgan throughout this complaint. We have also attached C4 report #110134738, filed 02/06/2023, to dispute Mr. Morgan's claim that our first report of the year was filed late. The report that he cited, #11013721, was an amendment to the original C4 report.

Now, to address the primary allegations of the latest Glen Morgan complaint.

1. Allegation 1: Violation of RCW 42.17A.235 & .240 for failure to timely & accurately disclose carry forward balance.
 - a. Per the attached email dated 01/20/2022, the Democrats of Pacific County (previously known as the Pacific County Democrats) has presently been a club that accepts contributions and makes expenditures to support area youth and local food banks.
 - b. We re-constituted as a Bona Fide Party Committee prior to accepting contributions or making expenditures to support or oppose candidates or ballot measures, and per RCW 42.17A.240 (1) we reported the funds on hand at the beginning of the period.
 - c. We have records of the sources of funds that made up our starting balance of \$2,120.12, and can report those sources and receipts if needed.

d. The funds in question were spent in March of 2023 on fundraising expenses for the Democrats of Pacific County Crab Feed, as reported on C4 report #110145548 (not attached).

2. Allegation 2: Violation of RCW 42.17A.235 &.240 for failure to disclose contributor detail for in-kind contributions.

a. While all in-kind contributions have been recorded and reported to the PDC, we acknowledge the lack of vendor information.

b. The missing vendor information is being gathered now and all pertinent reports will be amended immediately upon receipt of vendor details.

c. The requirements for accurately recording and reporting in-kind contributions is better understood now, and we anticipate correct and complete reporting to the PDC going forward.

Dear Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on March 26, 2018. The complaint alleged that the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee, a bona fide political party organization registered with the PDC, may have violated RCW 42.17A by failing to properly dissolve as a political party committee, preserve the committee's books of account, and to return excess contributions that exceeded the anonymous contribution limits.

PDC staff reviewed the allegations listed in the complaint, the statutes, rules and reporting requirements, the Monetary Contributions report (C-3 report) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) filed by the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee (Committee), and the response letter and email exchanges between Committee officers and PDC staff. Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On February 3, 2017, the Committee filed a Committee Registration (C-1pc report) as a Continuing Bona Fide Political Party Committee, selecting the Full Reporting Option, and listing James Clancy as the Committee Manager and Treasurer. The Committee has been registered and reporting with the PDC since June 1997.
- On January 10, 2018, the Committee filed a December 2017 C-4 report which was marked as a "Final report" disclosing \$22,177.60 in expenditures made that included a \$16,700 to the Washington State Democratic Central Committee, and a \$5,050 expenditure to the South Pacific County Community Foundation for scholarships. The Final C-4 report was filed by the Committee prior to the March 26, 2018, 76 days prior to the complaint being filed.
- Staff's review of the Final C-4 report discovered that the Committee disclosed receiving \$19,975 in total contributions, but made expenditures totaling \$35,899, for a negative (\$15,925) balance on line 18 of the report. Staff reviewed the C-4 reports filed for 2017 and found the January 2017 did not have a carryforward balance as the beginning cash on hand from 2016. Staff contacted the Committee and advised they

conduct a reconciliation of the bank statements and C-4 reports from 2016 and 2017 to determine the scope of the error.

- James Clancy, Treasurer for the Committee responded after conducting a review and indicated that the original C-4 report filed for January 2017 “was submitted with a variety of mistakes.” He stated the most substantial error was that the Committee failed to carry forward the cash on hand balance from the December 2016 C-4 report, as the beginning balance for calendar year 2017. He added that since the Online Reporting of Campaign Activity (ORCA), the campaign finance software developed by PDC staff “does not enforce an initial cash position, I overlooked this entry. The carry forward balance as of January 1, 2017 should have been \$14,545.01 instead of the zero amount, that included \$11,37743 in the Committee checking account; \$3,165.65 in GNNWCU shares; and \$214.29 in PayPal funds.”
- In addition, Mr. Clancy stated that the Committee discovered that contributions received through two Committee vendors, PayPal and Square, were excluded from contribution information that was cut and pasted from the .CVS formatted report and were not entered into ORCA totaling \$1,289. The Committee entered in the missing contribution information and filed amended C-3 reports disclosing \$1,289 in new contributions.
- Between November 26 through 28, 2018, the Committee filed 24 amended C-4 reports, including an amended Final C-4 report for December of 2017 disclosing \$36,128.09 in total contributions and \$36,180.22 in total expenditures, and a negative (\$52.13) cash on hand balance. The Committee was not able to determine the source of the negative balance, but the amount represents less than .14 percent of all committee activities.
- On June 21, 2017, the Committee filed a C-3 report disclosing the receipt of \$2,382 in contributions received and deposited on March 18, 2018, that included \$1,165 in contributions disclosed on line 1a of the report as anonymous contributions. rather than small non-itemized contributions. The Committee was limited to receiving \$300 in anonymous contributions during calendar year 2017, at the time of the event in accordance with RCW 42.17A.220(4).
- PDC staff notified Mr. Clancy about the anonymous contribution limits and asked if the Committee could identify the source of the anonymous contributions disclosed on the C-3 report and he filed an amended C-3 report disclosing that information.
- Mr. Clancy stated the Committee conducted a thorough review of the receipts for the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee Crab Feed, which was the fundraising event held on March 18, 2017, and he filed an amended C-3 report reducing the amount of anonymous contributions to \$875. The remaining \$875 disclosed as anonymous contributions, included:
 1. \$840 of the anonymous contribution total was received at the Crab Feed and he suspected that most of the anonymous contributions came from sales of food or simple contributions, for which neither he nor the Committee had records.
 2. The remaining \$35 in anonymous contributions came from a meeting in the summer 2017.
- Mr. Clancy stated that during his time as Committee Treasurer, he was not aware of the low-cost fund raiser reporting option and added that had he known at the time of the events the Committee likely could have disclosed the contributions received at those events as proceeds from a low-cost fundraiser. In addition, he stated that he was also not aware of the \$300 anonymous contribution limit.
- Since the Committee could not identify the source of the of contributions received at the Crab Feed and meeting, the \$875 in contribution received were truly anonymous contributions and those contributions are subject to a \$300 limitation in accordance with RCW 42.17A.220(4). PDC staff informed the Committee that based on the statute, the \$575 in anonymous contributions that exceeded the \$300 limit must be returned or “escheat” to the state for deposit into the state General Fund.

- On December 21, 2018, the PDC received a check for \$575 from the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee for exceeding the anonymous contribution limits, that was forwarded to the Department of Enterprise Services, a state agency that processes and handles small agencies collections, for deposit into the state General Fund in accordance with the statute.

Pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(b), the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee have been formally warned concerning their failure to timely file Monetary Contributions reports (C-3 reports) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports) disclosing contribution and expenditure activities, including carrying forward the correct cash on hand from the prior year, properly accounting for contributions received, and adherence to the anonymous contribution limit. The formal written warning will include staff's expectation that the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee will timely file accurate and complete C-3 and C-4 reports in future years, should the Committee become active again in accordance with PDC laws and rules. The Commission will consider the formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.

Based on the above, the PDC has dismissed your complaint in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1)(a).

Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed against the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee (Committee), a Continuing Bona Fide Political Party Committee registered with the PDC. The complaint alleged that the Committee may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 by failing to timely file Monetary Contribution reports (C-3 report) and Summary Full Campaign Contribution and Expenditure reports (C-4 reports).

Staff reviewed the allegation listed in the complaint you filed, the statutes, rules and reporting requirements, the C-1pc, C-3 and C-4 reports filed by the Committee, and the response to the complaint provided by the Committee's Officers.

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- On March 2, 2016, the Committee filed a Committee Registration (C-1pc report) as a Continuing Bona Fide Political Party Committee, selecting the Full Reporting Option, and listing Lisa Ayers as the Committee Treasurer, and Kevin Spackman as Chair. The Committee has been registered and reporting with the PDC since June 1997.
- On February 3, 2017, the Committee filed a Committee Registration (C-1pc report) as a Continuing Bona Fide Political Party Committee, selecting the Full Reporting Option, and listing James Clancy as the Committee Manager and Treasurer.
- On June 3, 2016, the Committee filed C-3 and C-4 reports disclosing contribution and expenditure information covering the period beginning January 1, 2016 and ending May 31, 2016. The C-3 and C-4 reports disclosed the Committee received \$13,267 in monetary contributions and carried forward \$20,414 in funds remaining from 2015 election year and made \$9,677 in expenditures that were disclosed between 24 and 145 days late.

- On December 18, 2016, the Committee filed C-3 and C-4 reports disclosing contribution and expenditure information covering the period beginning July 1 and ending November 30, 2016.
- The C-3 and C-4 reports disclosed the Committee received \$5,533 in new monetary contributions received during the period and made \$15,177 in new expenditures that included more than \$10,000 in monetary contributions to candidates. The C-3 and C-4 reports were disclosed by the Committee between 47 and 99 days late, and more than 40 days after the November 8, 2016 general election.
- Mr. Clancy, the Committee's most recent Treasurer acknowledged that the 2016 C-3 and C-4 reports were filed late. On January 10, 2018, the Committee filed a December 2017 C-4 report which was marked as a "Final report" disclosing \$22,177.60 in expenditures made that included a \$16,700 to the Washington State Democratic Central Committee, and a \$5,050 expenditure to the South Pacific County Community Foundation for scholarships.
- On April 11, 2019, the Committee: (1) submitted a signed Statement of Understanding acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 for failing to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports during calendar year 2016, and paid a \$300 civil penalty for violating RCW 42.17A.235; and (2) filed a C-1pc report as an "Other Committee" selecting the Mini Reporting Option and attaching a memorandum stating the Committee was registering for a short window of period for the sole purpose of soliciting small contributions to pay for the \$300 penalty assessed by the PDC.

As noted above, the Pacific County Democratic Central Committee completed a Statement of Understanding (SOU) and paid a \$300 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 for failing to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports during the 2016 election year. The \$300 penalty assessed resolves the allegations concerning the failure to timely and accurately file C-3 and C-4 reports.

Based on this information, the PDC has dismissed the complaint in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).

Dear Mr. Morgan:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) has completed its review of the complaint you filed on December 30, 2021. The complaint alleged that Pacific County Democrats, may have violated RCW 42.17A.235 and 240 by failing to timely and accurately file contribution and expenditure reports.

PDC staff reviewed your allegation(s); the attachments provided with the complaint; the applicable statute(s), rule(s), and reporting requirements; and the January 7, 2022, and January 20, 2021, responses to the complaint provided by former Treasurer James Clancy and Mike Cassinelli, respectively, on behalf of The Democrats of Pacific County Club (previously known as the Pacific County Democrats).

Based on staff's review, we found the following:

- The Pacific County Democrats was a Continuing Political Party committee registered and reporting with the PDC until the end of calendar year 2017 when they formally dissolved as a political party committee.
- The Pacific County Democrats have not made any candidate or political action committee contributions since December 26, 2017, when it filed its final C-4 report and transferred \$16,699.60 in cash on hand leftover to the Washington State Democrats and closed their bank account.
- As part of PDC Case 24460, on April 11, 2019, the Pacific County Democrats submitted a signed Statement of Understanding (SOU) acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 for failing to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports during calendar year 2016 and paid a \$300 civil penalty for violating RCW 42.17A.235.
- The Pacific County Democrats also filed a C-1pc report and registered as an "Other Committee" selecting the Mini Reporting Option and attaching a memorandum stating the Committee was registering for a short or brief window of time. The memorandum explained that the Pacific County Democrats sole purpose for registering with the PDC was to solicit enough funds in small contributions to pay for the \$300 penalty assessed by the PDC as agreed to in the SOU.

- The memorandum stated that the \$300 in small contributions raised to pay the \$300 SOU penalty is the only activity that the Pacific County Democrats will be engaging in, and further stated that once PDC Case 24460 is resolved, the Committee will have no other purpose and will once again be dissolved and cease operations.
- Since the Pacific County Democrats is dissolved, the \$1,000 disposal of Dean Takko’s surplus funds contribution received in 2021 did not trigger the contribution prong for a political committee or political party organization requiring a Committee Registration with the PDC. Pursuant to RCW 42.17A.430, “The disposal of surplus funds under this section shall not be considered a contribution for the purposes of this chapter.”

Based on the above review, PDC staff has determined that, in this instance, no evidence supports a finding of a violation that warrants further investigation.

Based on this information, the PDC finds that no further action is warranted and has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
