Subject: PDC Case 176151 regarding Friends of KVH

Friends of KVH:

The Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) completed its review of the complaint filed by Conner Edwards on July 16, 2025. The complaint alleged violations of RCW 42.17A.235 & .240 for failure to timely and accurately disclose contributions and expenditures on reports.

Applicable Laws and Rules

Pursuant to [RCW 42.17A.235\(3\)\(a\)](#), each treasurer of a candidate or political committee is required to file a report on the tenth day of each month during which they are not participating in an election campaign only if the committee 1) received a contribution or made an expenditure in the preceding calendar month; and 2) either total contributions received or total expenditures made since the last such report exceed \$750.

Pursuant to [RCW 42.17A.240\(2\)](#), monetary contributions are disclosed on C-3 reports, which must include, but are not limited to: 1) the name and address of each person who contributed more than \$100 during the period covered by the report; 2) the monetary value and date of each contribution, except for the items specifically mentioned in subsection (2)(a) through (g); and 3) the aggregate value of all contributions received from each person during the campaign. "Contribution," as defined, includes an in-kind contribution, which is disclosed on a C-4 report.

Background and Findings

- The Respondent showed that the required reporting had been entered into the PDC's Online Reporting of Campaign Activity (ORCA) system, but they had not filed the reports.
- PDC Staff noticed the Respondent for Initial Hearing to be held on October 24, 2025 on October 20, 2025.
- PDC Staff noticed the Respondent of the Initial Hearing results on October 24, 2025.

- The Respondent was noticed for a Brief Adjudicative Hearing to be held on December 4, 2025, on November 21, 2025.
- With assistance from PDC Staff the Respondent was able to file the C-3 and C-4 reports on November 24, 2025.
- The Respondent received \$10,501 in contributions and expended \$8,464.19 during the campaign.
- On December 1, 2025 the PDC received a signed Statement of Understanding (SOU) from the Respondent, acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and .240.
- On December 18, 2025 the PDC received payment of \$300 for the SOU from the Respondent.

Summary and Resolution

You completed a Statement of Understanding (SOU) and paid a \$300 civil penalty in accordance with WAC 390-37-143 (Brief Enforcement Penalty Schedule), acknowledging violations of RCW 42.17A.235 and RCW 42.17A.240 for failing to timely file C-3 and C-4 reports during the 2025 election campaign. The \$300 penalty assessed resolves the allegations listed in this case.

Based on this information, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1).
